Pitchers Clinics \$15 (for either or both days)

9am—12pm Ages 8—12

1pm—4pm Ages 13 & Up

These sessions stress proper pitching mechanics to gain velocity and accuracy. Older pitchers will be exposed to different pitch types.

Catchers Clinic \$10 (for either or both days)

9am—12pm Ages 10—12

1pm—4pm Ages 13 & Up

Fundamentals from the stance to the throw down. Covers footwork, throwing technique, blocking, bunt coverage, giving signs, framing pitches & executing pickoffs. There will be 2 hours of instruction followed by 1 hour of working with the pitchers.
